## **IMPACT OF ORGANIZATIONAL CULTURE ON ORGANIZATIONAL EFFICIENCY**

**Abstract.** *The article examines the influence of the maturity of leadership (management) on the relationship between organizational culture and the effectiveness of the organization from the point of view of employees. Many companies encounter failed management initiatives and find that such failures are the result of imitating management tools without examining the philosophy behind them. Thus, in this study, a managerial maturity constraint model was built to explore the impact of a bureaucratic, innovative, supportive culture on organizational performance. The data were collected using questionnaires distributed through the website of a large engineering company. The results show that managerial maturity moderates the relationship between innovation culture and organizational performance; that is, employees who perceived a higher level of managerial maturity from their management team were also more positive about the results of their organization. However, this does not apply to a bureaucratic or supportive culture. Leadership maturity is vital, though long neglected, as it has a moderately positive deterrent effect on innovation culture and a moderately negative deterrent effect on bureaucratic and supportive culture.*

***Abstract.** The time period from 18 January to 24 February 2022 is undoubtedly unique in economic terms. At this time, stock markets in the Russian Federation experienced abnormal volatility, leading to their catastrophic fall, which had no parallel in the history of stock markets in modern Russia. The 24 February recession was more than double the ta during the 2008 crisis, which can rightly be considered an absolute record. This event provoked an increase in the inflation rate in Russia, causing the Central Bank's key rate to rise from 9.5% to 20%. These factors contributed to the hypothesis of a deliberate collapse of Russia's stock markets by a number of Western states and, consequently, their intervention in the Russian economy to weaken it. This raises the questions of "was the intervention in the Russian economy intentional, what did it represent and what was the purpose of the structures that intervened in the economy of the Russian Federation?".*

**Abstract.** *The paper considers certain aspects of the theft differentiation and the appropriation of what was found. It justifies that the appropriation of the found, as a rule, cannot be qualified as theft. A randomly found property does not have an owner at the moment. In fact, the owner at this particular moment cannot regulate, own or use the lost property not through the fault of the person, who picked up and appropriated these belongings. The qualification of such act as theft does not correspond to the general principles of criminal law and theoretical provisions characteristics of theft in criminal law. This is especially true for the implementation of the principles of legality and justice, according to which the guilty person is criminally liable only for what is recognized by criminal law as a crime. By analogy, criminal prosecution is prohibited. In order to eliminate the conflict that has arisen in the assignment of the found and the qualification of the committed act as theft, it is proposed to conduct a new corpus delicti, which provides for criminal liability for the misappropriation of someone else's property found.*
